Austin Beutner is the former publisher and CEO of the *Los Angeles Times* and the *San Diego Union-Tribune*.

Beutner was co-founder, President and co-CEO of Evercore Partners and helped build the company into one of the leading independent investment banks in the world.

In 2010, Beutner served as First Deputy Mayor and Jobs Czar for the City of Los Angeles. In that role, he oversaw the policy and operations of 13 city departments ranging from the Los Angeles World Airports, the Port of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, to the Departments of Planning, Building and Safety, and Housing and Homeless.

He currently serves on the Boards of CalArts, The Broad Stage, the Mammoth Mountain Community Foundation, The California Nature Conservancy, The Los Angeles Fund for Public Education, the Pacific Council on International Relations, and the U.S. Ski and Snowboard Team Foundation; and is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations. In 2012, he created Vision To Learn, a nonprofit that provides free eyeglasses to children in low-income communities in California and Delaware.
