The National Park Foundation is recruiting for various internship positions. The internship program is designed to provide a professional learning opportunity that will translate into educational enrichment and potential career introduction.

The internships will offer an excellent opportunity to gain real-world experience working with a mission-driven national non-profit organization. Internships will begin early June 2019 and conclude by Mid-August 2019. Below is a list of available internships:

GOVERNMENT RELATIONS

The intern will aid the Government Relations team that will expose her/him to real world GR experience and contribute towards NPF achieving its goals. The intern will be fully integrated into the GR and External Affairs teams by attending team meetings and other team events. The intern would play a leading role in organizing Hill briefings including working with Congressional staff on location, invitations, agendas and attendance at the briefings.

The Intern will assist the team with new business development strategies. The main project would be to assist in the development of a point of sale campaign strategy, which would include the opportunity to work with Corporate, Marketing, Communications, Brand Development, and outside agency.
