Wright Construction Co. She serves on the boards of WSU College of Engineering Advisory Board and The Frye Museum. She is a founder and trustee of several philanthropic associations, including the National Park Foundation's National Council, Washington Women's Foundation, YWCA Endowment Guild, Pediatric Brain Tumor Research Fund, and PBTRF Guild at Children's Hospital. She received an Alumni Achievement Award from WSU in 2009.
