William E. “Bill” Grayson is a financier, attorney and public servant who is currently the National Director of Family Offices at Bernstein Private Wealth Management. Mr. Grayson was previously president of Falcon Point Capital, vice president of J.P. Morgan & Co, and vice president of Montgomery Securities, the predecessor to Banc of America Securities. Previously, he served as the principal deputy general counsel of the Army in the Pentagon.

Mr. Grayson is the chairman of the Presidio Trust board of directors and was appointed to the board by the President in 2017. He also serves as the vice chair of the University of Hawaii Foundation board of trustees. Previously, Mr. Grayson served on the investment committees of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars and Dominican University of California, and on the boards of the Bay Area Discovery Museum, the USF School of Law and UC Berkeley’s Institute of Governmental Studies. Mr. Grayson also served for seven years on the President’s Commission on White House Fellowships.

Mr. Grayson holds a JD from the University of San Francisco School of Law, a certificate in defense policy from Harvard, and a BA from the University of California, Santa Barbara. He and his wife Laurie live in San Francisco and have three daughters.
